What this means to us....

- Aligns with Senate goals of Guided pathways and Career and Networking Exploration
 - More course options that feed into those CSU's with more robust media programs
 - Makes our program more equitable for our students, with the space and equipment
 - Increases job readiness skills that fit an ever-changing economic landscape of media
- Certain offerings we don't yet offer are only found in LA or OC

A Destination Program

- With the facility and equipment we can offer new classes that aren't offered within our region:
 - Broadcast Journalism
 - Sports Broadcasting
 - Reality TV Production
 - Color Correction and After Effects
 - These only exist now in OC, Fullerton College and LA City College
- This best aligns our program with the district direction of Guided Pathways

What it means for the campus
