



## SBCCD Academic Senates | Resolution S21.01

## Condemning Anti-Asian Racism and Violence

## **Proposed Amendments:**

- First and Second Whereas: Whereas, since March 2020, the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, acts of racism and violence against Asians and Asian Americans drastically increased 145%<sup>1</sup> nationwide<sup>2</sup>;
- 2. Strike Existing Third Whereas: Whereas, like any community facing violence and hate the Asian American Pacific Islander (AAPI) community members need the active support of others to aid in defending them against such acts;
- 3. **New Third Whereas:** Whereas, colleges and higher education institutions such as SBCCD perpetuate the Model Minority Myth, reenforcing the invisibility and both purposeful and passive neglect of AAPI communities;
- 4. Strike Existing Fourth Whereas: Whereas, the false idea that any AAPI person is self-sufficient and requires neither assistance nor attention (known as the "Model Minority Myth") perpetuates the invisibility and both purposeful and passive neglect of AAPI communities;
- 5. **Second Resolved:** Resolved, the faculty of SBCCD acknowledges the current reality of systemic racism and anti-Asian violence in our community and vows to ensure that our District becomes a welcoming space of inclusivity for everyone people of Asian descent;
