TRANSITION TO CAMPUS SURVEYS

STUDENTS

- Online-only most preferred method of classroom instruction (48.5%)
- Preferred methods of non-instructional and student support services tied (35.7%) between in-person only and online only.
- Hybrid modalities garnered the most neutral responses.
- More than half of respondents (54%0 indicated concerns regarding the transition back to campus, with issues of contracting/transmitting COVID and safety protocols and guidelines not being followed being primary areas of concern
- To mitigate, most students who responded said they'd like to see courses remain online for Fall 2021

FACULTY, STAFF, AND MANAGERS

- In-person-only least preferred method of classroom instruction (47%)
- More non-instructional faculty and student support staff in favor of inperson only (37%). Classified staff and managers were more evenly split on modality.
- Hybrid modalities garnered the most neutral responses.
- More than half of respondents (63%) indicated concerns regarding the transition back to campus, with issues of safety protocols and guidelines not being followed being primary areas of concern
- To mitigate, respondents recommended remote work, flexible schedules, and proper safety protocols
