Background

SBCCD brought together a team of faculty, staff, and administrators to implement a common application that will allow students to complete one admission application and enroll at SBVC or CHC. As part of the implementation, a Sub Committee was formed to explore any impact on courses, programs, and the Catalog. The table below identifies areas that need to be further examined by faculty and staff to collect input and feedback.
