WHY WE NEED TO ELEVATE ATHLETICS

- 1. Athletics plays a huge role in student life, marketing, sense of belonging, closing equity gaps, and community relations.
- 2. During the Spring 2025 semester, SBVC will narrow College priorities around Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) and maximizing the Student-Centered Funding Formula (SCFF).
- 3. Many sports have struggled with personnel issues, high turnover among coaching staff, tenured faculty choosing to teach and not coach, and a gap between Student Services and Instruction.
- 4. The current organization structure does not work with Athletics intersecting with Social Sciences, Student Engagement & Wellness, and Counseling & Matriculation.
- 5. Sports teams have opportunity to grow numbers.
- 6. SBVC has the opportunity to be among the first community colleges to compete in Women's Flag Football.
- 7. Athletics plays a huge role in increasing access to higher education.

THE SBVC FOOTBALL STORY

- SBVC Football season 2024 was cancelled for the first time in school history.
- 2. A dysfunctional SBVC Football Program hurts enrollment growth and worsens the equity gap for Black males.
- 3. The de-centralized approach to Athletics has not worked.
- 4. Personnel issues negatively impacted the Department and College.
- 5. Curriculum & coaching salaries have not kept pace with education and industry standards.

ELEVATING ATHLETICS 2025—THE PLAN

- 1. Create a Division of Kinesiology, Health, & Athletics under the VP of Instruction.
- 2. Move Athletics and The Huddle to the new Division of Kinesiology, Health, & Athletics.
- 3. Establish growth targets by sport and establish Women's Flag Football Team with a target date of Spring 2027.
- 4. Explore the feasibility of re-aligning Student Services and Instruction.
- 5. Explore student life opportunities like band, cheer, dance, drumline, etc. and work with stakeholders (K-12, KVCR SportsCentro, university partnerships, Dual Enrollment, etc.).

NEW STAFFING

- Instructional Dean of Kinesiology, Health, and Athletics
- 3rd Athletic Trainer DONE
- Administrative Assistant III
- Increase Counseling by 0.4
- Student Engagement Specialist

Work with CTA and HR to increase the number and amount of coaching stipends.

- December 5, 2024—Met with Athletics to share plan.
- December 9, 2024—Social Sciences, Human Development, and Physical Education Division meeting to share Athletics plan.
- January 16, 2025—Met with Andrew Wooten and The Huddle and invited The Huddle to President's Executive Cabinet meeting.
- February 4, 2025—Andrew Wooten and the Huddle presented at President's Executive Cabinet.
- February 5, 2025—Presentation at Academic Senate
- Spring 2025—Plan transition of Athletics from Student Services to Instruction.
- July 1, 2025—Projected start date for new Instructional Dean.
- July-December 2025—Recruit & hire classified positions for new instructional division.
