### **New Business/Discussion:**

- A. <u>Applebee's Pancake Breakfast Fundraiser, April 20</u>: Judy Rodriguez said we need volunteers to help at this event.
- B. <u>Classified Senate Conference</u>, <u>June 2019</u>: The Classified Senate proposed to do a vote to select an additional person from the E-board/Senate to attend this upcoming event. **Dena Peters motioned** to open up to nominate/vote for people from E-board/Senate; **Ernest Guillen 2**<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Three people were selected as nominees: Anabel Martinez; John Feist; Phylicia Sanchez. A vote was taken by those in attendance. Phylicia Sanchez received the most vote to attend the Classified Senate Conference in June. Funding will come from Guided Pathways.
- C. <u>Scholarships Update:</u> The E-board selected ten (10) awards of \$250 each.
- D. <u>Spotlight Awards Dinner:</u> Event on May 10, 2019. Judy encouraged classified staff to vote. The vote is being done via paper ballot for classified employee of the year. Discussion ensued on putting an ad in the Spotlight Award brochure. **Dena Peters motioned** to approve funding to put a quarter-page ad recognizing the nominees and annual retirees in the brochure; **Ernest Guillen 2**nd the motion, motion approved by general consensus. **Ernest Guillen motioned** to purchases two gift as congratulation gifts to the nominees, not to exceed \$80; **John Feist 2**nd the motion. Motion approved by general consensus.

Ernest Guillen motioned the funds to go to the general fund; John Feist 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. - Moving to Hospitality Lane by August; TESS will also move to this new location
- Promise Program, free education to a target market in the fall
- Salary/Benefit Negotiations going good this year; salary schedule at the median to compete with other colleges; benefits still negotiating.
- State & Promise Funds, have opted out, district will not provide loans to students. Promise is self-funded.
- Bond Projects, looking to sell off bonds, plan and build CTE first, next parking structure
- Class & Comp Study, to be completed every five years.
