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Agenda Items	
VPI Report	<p>We are moving forward with CurriQunet Meta as our new curriculum management system. We anticipate this going more quickly than usual because we already have CurricUNET. As we get closer, we will have trainings for faculty and will be exploring other modules within CurriQunet (i.e. SLO, Program Review).</p>
New Business	<p>Ethnic Studies Update: We are adding the ETHS to the local Associate’s Degree Graduation Requirements effective 2021/2022. The biggest change is the increase of units due to the fact that we are adding the ETHS requirements, similar to CSU. Though we do not have any approved ETHS courses to cover this new area, we will be able to back-date credit for this area for students. Please direct students to see a Counselor if they have any questions.</p> <p>Janice Wilkins recently attended an Articulation Conference and gained some insight on the Ethnic Studies topic. Information came through this conference that Ethnic Studies faculty at the 4-year institutions are looking for specific content and assignments. They are looking for a lot of detail that some of our courses may be missing (i.e. specific textbooks, organizations, etc.). The Chancellor’s Office will be hosting some Webinars for us to attend to ensure we are approving content that will be approved. It was also recommended that we invite experts from the State Chancellor’s Office and Cal State to meet with our Committee to provide additional information on what will be needed for each course.</p> <p>Social Justice – Ethnic Studies AA-T Degree. The State is in the process of deleting this TMC to be replaced by an Ethnic Studies TMC degree. A draft TMC has been completed and is in the process of being evaluated. Further discussion will be presented once more information is available.</p> <p>Synchronous vs. Asynchronous Instruction Presentation: Christie Gabriel Millette presented on material learned from various conferences and webinars she has attended. Many Institutional Researchers (IR) are looking into synchronous vs. asynchronous data from the student’s perspective. Looking at asynchronous data, students felt their point of view was acknowledged, and liked the discussion forums for starting conversations. Many students felt discussion boards are more personal than communicating face-to-face. In synchronous environments, many students felt that face to face discussions are much more personal than discussion boards. Some of us have a feeling that students do not have a connection, but the synchronous and asynchronous data is showing that students are comfortable interacting with faculty and other students in the online environment. The qualitative responses from students believe working asynchronously allows them to have more flexible schedules. The retention rates also show that students are doing a little better in the synchronous vs. asynchronous. They feel more comfortable and are doing a little better in synchronous courses. Christie will be meeting with the Online Committee next week and is available to meet with Faculty Chairs to delve deeper into the research possibilities for SBVC on this subject.</p>
