VPI Report	Bachelor's Degree Updates: We were provisionally approved to start building our Water Resources Management Bachelor of Arts degree. We will be working to submit a Substantive Change to the ACCJC, and we will be starting to build the courses.
New Business	Financial Aid: Samuel Trejo was invited to speak about financial aid and how it works with curriculum. The Curriculum Committee is thinking of the impact on financial aid when building low-unit new certificates. Certificates of less than 16 units are not eligible for financial aid. According to our Program Participation Agreement (PPA), it stipulates that any time a certificate is introduced through curriculum, it needs to be screened through the Department of Education. When a new certificate is created, Financial Aid works with the Office of Instruction to complete the PPA in order for this certificate to be eligible for financial aid. All degrees have financial aid approval, but certificates are added to the PPA. For noncredit courses and programs, are not eligible for financial aid. Mary Copeland asked if a student were taking 11 units and were enrolled into a noncredit course, they will be considered $\frac{3}{4}$ -time students, and the noncredit course will not help them receive full-time status. Low unit certificates will not make a student eligible for financial aid, but the department works with the student to determine what their declared major is so they may be eligible for financial aid if their financial aid is terminated. Students may also declare two majors in order to be eligible for financial aid. If a student only takes a low unit certificate, then they would not be eligible for financial aid. Students are cut off from financial aid after receiving 150% of the number of units required for the program (Associate's Degrees = 60 units, so it would be

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	<p>around 90 units). For student receiving the Pell Grant, if a student transfers to a 4-year institution, financial aid will cover up to 600% towards their degree, or 6 full-time years of receiving the Pell Grant.</p> <p>Local Degree/AB 928: Janice Wilkins gave an update on AB 928 and the local degree. Last week, the BoG approved the changes to Title 5. This means that local degrees will need to align with CalGETC, hopefully for the 2025/2026 academic year, we are still waiting for the official timeline. We can still add areas to our local degree, but we will need to have discussions campus-wide to determine what we'd like to be on our local degree.</p>
