New Business	<p>AB 928 Updates: Janice Wilkins gave an update and overview on CalGETC (GE requirements). Compared different models applicable to our local GE pattern. After visiting division meetings on February 9th and the 14th, the Curriculum Committee will be reviewing the proposed GE patterns on the online March 4th meeting and will be voting (in-person) on March 25th.</p> <p>Curriculum Charge: Mary Copeland shared the committee charge. <i>Current charge</i> - Under AB1725, the Academic Senate has a responsibility to make recommendations with respect to Academic and Professional matters. Curriculum is an academic matter and, therefore, the curriculum committee is authorized by the Academic Senate to make recommendations about the curriculum of the college, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approval of new courses • Deletion of existing courses • Proposed changes in course • Periodic review of course outlines • Approval of proposed programs • Deletion of programs • Review of degree and certificate requirements

The Curriculum Committee recommends that the pre-requisites and co-requisites approved be re-evaluated in the next 2-3 years by the appropriate departments/programs to ensure student success.
