<b>New Business</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Curriculum Chair:</b> The Academic Senate voted for Thomas Berry to be our next Curriculum Committee Co-Chair beginning Fall 2024.</li> <li>• <b>AB-928 Updates:</b> Janice Wilkins gave a presentation on AB-928. On March 27<sup>th</sup> the CSUs officially voted to adopt the new CalGETC. This means that Lifelong Learning will be removed as a GE requirement at the Cal State's effective Fall 2025. The next step will be for our campus to see what we would like to do for Lifelong Learning. We will be extending the AB-928 Steering Committee work from Spring 2024 through Spring 2025.</li> <li>• <b>AB-1111 Updates:</b> A report was released that gives the framework or guidelines for Common Course Number (CCN). The State is starting to look at six courses to align (College Composition, Argumentative Writing and Critical Thinking, Public Speaking, Intro to Statistics, Intro to American Government and Politics, Intro to Psychology). The elements that need to be identical are the Course Number, Course Title, Course Description, Content, Prerequisites, and Outcomes/Objectives. There are options to extend or expand above and beyond the identical areas. They are proposing to give us the descriptors for the six courses by August and should be updated in our catalog by April 2025.</li> <li>• <b>Class Cap Update:</b> Class caps have been added to Meta.</li> <li>• <b>Spring Plenary Resolutions:</b> Mary Copeland shared some resolutions related to curriculum that will be at the Spring Plenary.</li> </ul>

The Curriculum Committee recommends that the pre-requisites and co-requisites approved be re-evaluated in the next 2-3 years by the appropriate departments/programs to ensure student success. Note: Committee members are voting on all Proposals, Requisites, Advisories, and Distance Education.
