Additional Required Processes:

Faculty may submit a proposal to assign a discipline to a course at the same time with corresponding course proposal in Meta. After submitting this form to the Curriculum Faculty Chair (tberry@sbccd.edu) and Curriculum Administrator (dhumble@sbccd.edu), the Office of Instruction will note the discipline to Meta and to the Course Outline of Record. The discipline and any corresponding courses and programs are not considered approved until they complete the Curriculum Committee approval process, have been submitted for board approval, and have received State approval.

Assignment of a Discipline to a Course Approval Process:

- 1. Department Approval
 - a. Originator attaches minutes showing the department's approval.
- 2. Form submitted to Curriculum Faculty Chair and Curriculum Administrator.
- 3. Technical Review Committee Review
 - a. Technical Review Committee will review all courses and programs that include the proposed discipline assigned for a course.
 - b. If any technical issues are found in the curriculum, the proposal is sent back to the Originator for corrections.
- 4. Curriculum Committee Approval
 - a. If the Curriculum Committee does not approve, the proposal is sent back to the Originator for corrections.
- 5. Board of Trustee Approval
- 6. Implementation
 - a. New discipline assigned to the course can now be noted in Meta and will be added to the Course Outline of Record.
