| Canvas and the OEI | Crafton seems to be on board with shifting from Blackboard to Canvas to facilitate participation in the OEI. Again, lengthy discussion about whether the "decision has already been made at higher levels" and whether any discussion was a waste of time. The consensus that developed was that there needed to be a time line for having this conversation and making a decision. The suggested timeline was to take the fall and early spring to investigate Canvas and compare and take an assessment of what it would really take to make the move. Then by the end of the spring semester, the Academic Senate could vote and we could see where we are at that point. |
