Student Equity and Achievement     Program Overview: Dr. Scott Thayer /     Carmen Rodriguez	Dr. Thayer: Overview of new SE and achievement program-integrate 3 components: SSSP, Basic Skills and Student Equity. Focus on requirement to update SE Plan by June 30, 2019. Running parallel with State Vision for Success goals. 6 goals-state chancellor office (Dr. Thayer) Rodriguez: Handout- include over all student population. Will send out emails to departments who request SE funding (monies) Dr. Thayer: Sharing 2 things: new program/ SE plan update. 3 year plan; new plan will be from 2019-2022. How do we close achievement stats for students who have been identified? How do we accomplishes goals that have been identified? Will be informative as we update the plan. How do we bring all of	

these thing together to support student success? Create 1 document in support of students. We have three committees and they need to come together. Rodriguez: #1 is general population #2ASG; have to go to May board meeting Millette: Data will not be available until end of month...... Rodriguez: Different programs have data Dr. Thayer: Identify everything we have been doing. We're pretty close to being fully staffed so we don't have carry over monies. SE plan must be completed by June 3, 2019. Millette: We will not be using internal data any longer. Data on demand data.....be cautious on how we acquire data. Dr. Thayer: .....floating idea of a retreat.... Dr. Weiss: retreat with all 3 committees Dr. Thaver: whomever we think needs to be there; look at data, activity and decide what it should look like Dr. Thayer: Board had discussion about **Promise Program Update: Dr. Scott** promise program. 10 Million dollars set Thayer aside, want to expand VB program. Application process has been left open so students can continue to apply. Structure already in place, just a matter of how many students we will serve (about 700). Go out to feeder schools to let them know that district is offering free tuition for 2 years. Fulltime students....this is on top of financial aid. Dale-Carter: priority registration would not be offered? Fees? VB student placed on sponsorship, manually. We will need more staffing or have IT put this in computer, special coding. Dr. Thayer: Can you bring up at next DAWG meeting? Will not have priority registration for all students; some of them may have this. Lot of transitioning...... Dale-Carter: Will priority registration only be for current VB students or will it be extended out? Dr. Thayer: Sum/Fall registration is April....when is date we need to know when to assign groups for priority registration? Identify challenge and fix it. Dr. Thayer: snapshot handout-today v. **Enrollment Update** last year; 21 more students today than last year; active seats -251; FTE -1535. Humble: nothing to add
