1. Approval of 10/8/2024 Minutes	Brian Thompson moved to approve; Keenan Giles seconded. Minutes approved as written.	
2. Enrollment Update – Dr. Humble	Dr. Humble gave the enrollment update. Priority registration is at over 2,000 students and almost 1,000 FTE's. Right now we are surpassing our District target at just over 100 FTE's and are looking at around 10,507 FTE's for the academic year. We are having some issues with rooms and scheduling had to be done by hand.	
Successful Enrollment Labs & Priority Registration – Dr. Rosas; K.Giles; K. Heilgeist	Priority registration is going on and labs have been a success. Keenan reported Priority Registration goes through November 21. Communications	

have gone out to students and block parties are being held for each group. The week of Thanksgiving is when open registration begins. Kristina reported each group had received their own email with prior notification. The class schedule was embedded as well as the flyer. They also received a text message that links them to Self Service and Registration. Starfish was discussed with current daily registration numbers. Kristina also went through a training session on how to contact students and what attributes and filters to use. The only group not included is the Veterans, and they can be added. Ed Plans are included in the filters. Keenan shared they will be working with Research to develop surveys. Rania recommended the faculty post something in their Canvas Shell to remind students to register. April reported that a ticket must be created and submitted to TESS to have a student group for your specific program created. It is not automatic. Dr. Rosas updated the group on 4.
