Updates: (30 Min)	 Scale of Adoption (SOAA) – Ty: The report went to Senate last week and it was approved as submitted. It will now go to College Counsel next and will go to the next board meeting. We are making progress in the Educators of Color, partnering with CSUSB and San Bernardino Unified. Ty was able to get a hold of the CTA students who may be interested in doing a pilot with Cal State this coming fall. There were questions about the mapping and how it was done, there are some objections going along. There were also questions about the budget of the Guided Pathways and Dina offered to prepare a budget to submit to the next meeting. Senate Resolution and Diversity and Equity Group Updates – John: At the Academic Senate last Wednesday, the Senate approved the SOAA as presented and they approved the recommended changes to AP 7210. Communications Group – Kyle: We have been working hard on the information received from the questionnaire sent out to the campus and they are moving forward with marketing on a newsletter. Right now, we are going to keep it simple in order to get it out this month. Program Map Group – Matt: A few big things happened over the last few weeks. They met with 40-50 Department chairs and conversations evolved around the mapping and how we can further
