

## Mhy do we have SAOs?

We write, assess, and evaluate Service Area Outcomes to:

- Highlight what we do well
- Improve our programs and services for students and user groups
- Increase dialogue about the quality of our programs and services
- Collaborate with colleagues
- Discuss best practices
- Satisfy accreditation requirements

### Who has SAOs?



All Student Services and Administrative Services departments or programs that participate in Program Review independently, or as part of a larger area, should have SAOs.

## How often are SAOs assessed?

- Currently...
- Ideally, SAOs are assessed at least annually
  - We need to establish a formal process in writing



### Recommended Processes

#### **SAO** Establishment

- New SAOs should be emailed to the SLO Faculty Lead
  - Cc their manager

#### **SAO** Assessment

- SAOs should be assessed at least once per year
  - Some areas may benefit from once per semester
  - Results should be emailed to their manager and the SLO Faculty Lead, then posted to the Outcomes webpage
- Assessment results are used in Program Review

### Recommended Processes

#### Analyze SAO Data

- Use the SAO assessment data to make meaningful changes in your areas
- Highlight what works

#### **SAO** Evaluation

- Program Review ensures that your area has SAOs
- Evaluate the effectiveness of your area's SAOs
- Accreditation and Outcomes Committee draft <u>review</u> cycle
