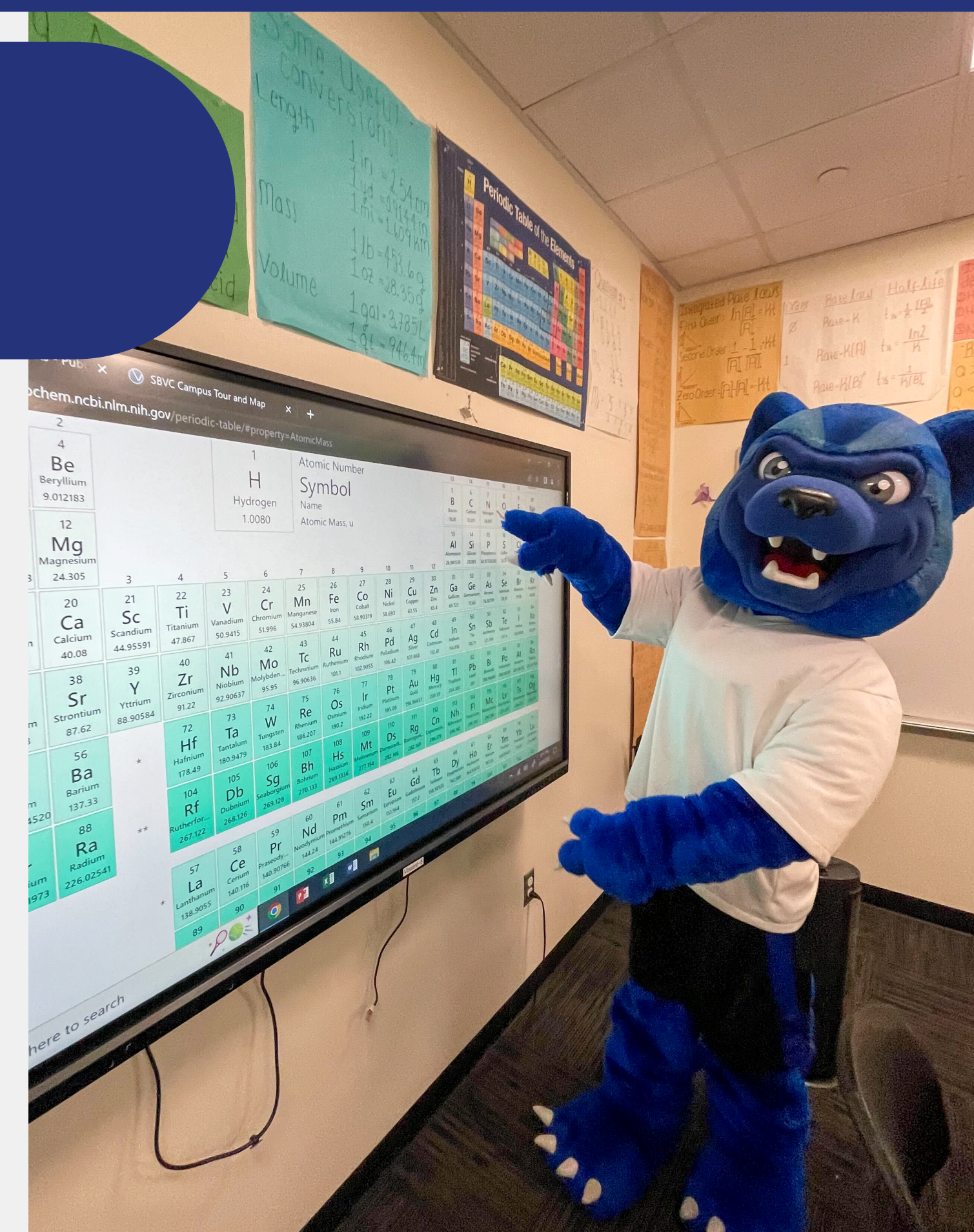

Seeding Strategies to Close the Calculus Equity Gap

Purpose: **Redesign SBVC's calculus sequence with a focus on student success, engagement, and active learning to close equity gaps across gender, race/ethnicity, and first-generation categories.**

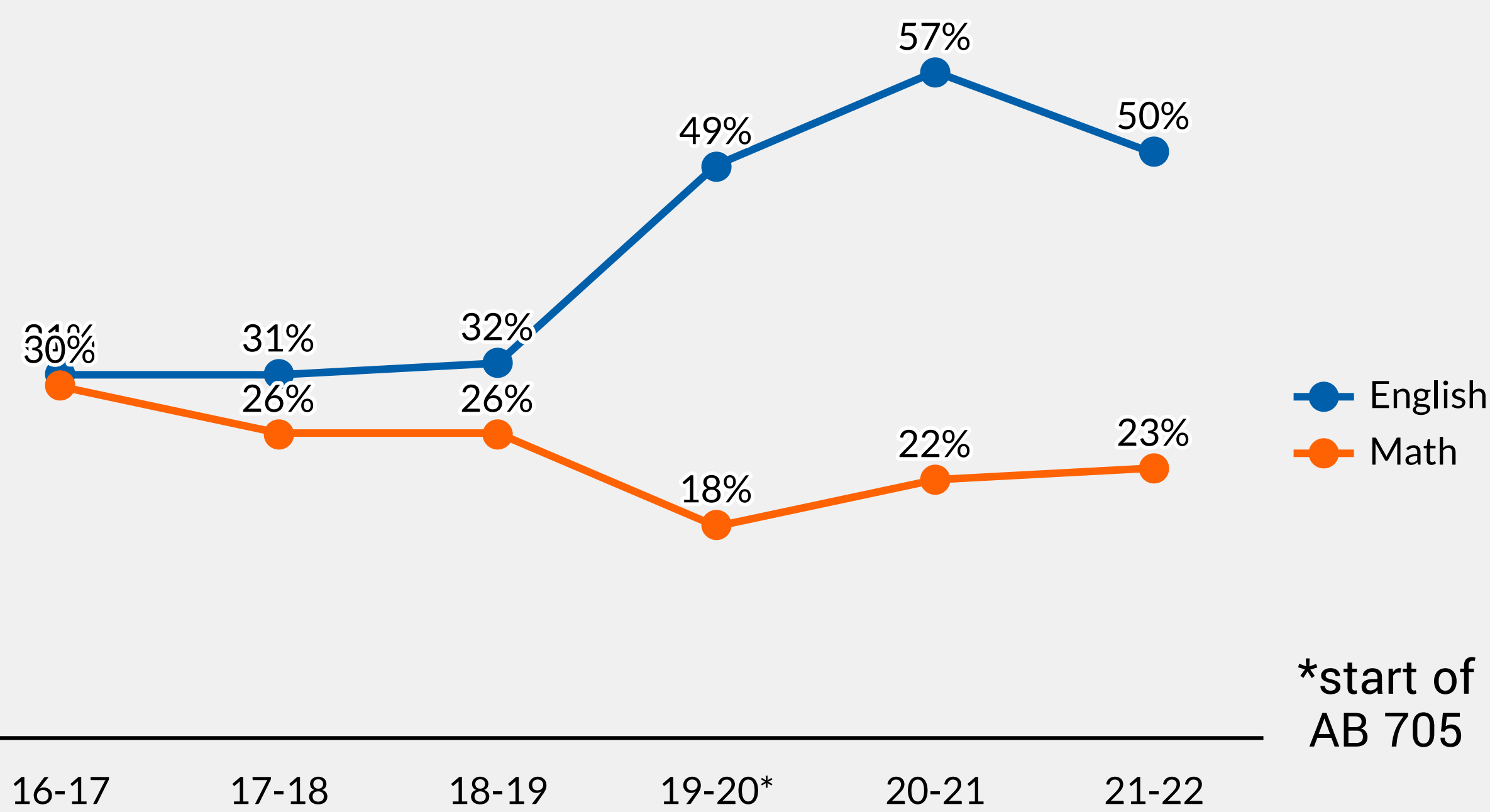
