Concurrent Enrollment Programs (CEP) allow SBVC Nursing students to complete Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) courses while completing their Associate of Science (A.S.) in Nursing courses at SBVC. Below are the prerequisites required by our partner universities. Note: Students must submit a SBVC Nursing Application between March 1st - 15th for Fall entry or August 15th - 31st for Spring entry to be considered for a CEP. Acceptance and enrollment into the SBVC A.S. in Nursing program is required prior to enrollment in a CEP. A minimum science prerequisites GPA of 2.8 and general education prerequisites GPA of 3.0 is required to apply.
