Discussion and Action

SLO Cloud

Celia Huston discussed a conference that she and Haragewen Kinde attended where SLO cloud storage was discussed. After the session they had a follow-up meeting with one of the researchers from CHC about the possibility of implimeting a a cloud storage system for SLOs and PLOs in our district. Subsequently, Celia Huston and James Smith scheduled a meeting with both researchers from CHC and Jason Brady, the district web-master, to review the details of a pilot system being developed for our district.

Celia shared a powerpoint presentation that contained a mock-up (generic version) of its current stage of development. The program platform can be used to enter and maintain SLO and PLO data. Discussion ensued on the pilot program for the data collection phase; when will it be available? ... how instructors would get to the reporting page?...can a link be posted to WebAdvisor?

We see it as a possible replacement for Elumen that we have 100% control over. However, there are still numerous unanswered questions about the rollout of this new system, and we do not yet know the full range of possibilities. We will not use it this year. This year, deans will send request for paper SLO responses from faculty.

We're looking at a December deadline to complete this project. Data collection is currently in the works. Research has a student worker on this project, and then Jason (Brady) will be uploading the data to the cloud. Discussion on how this will apply to the accreditation process. A report is due in April 2015.

A motion was made and approved to support this pilot project of the SLO cloud and to discuss in spring 2015. Kay Weiss made the motion and it was seconded by James Smith

Discussion ensued on mapping and evaluation of SLOs.
