ILOs:	Joanna Oxendine had questions for the committee regarding Institutional Learning Outcomes (ILOs). Specifically, when were they last reviewed? According to the website, the most recent review took place in 2021. The committee should ensure that ILOs are continuously evaluated and updated as needed. She also inquired about the mapping process for ILOs. Currently, ILOs are mapped at both the course level (SLOs) and the program level (PLOs), with reviews occurring at each stage.	
Standard 1 Review:	Thomas Berry led the conversation in continuing to review Standard 1.  1.5 – Developed to Emerging. If we lack documentation, the ACCJC visiting team may request additional evidence, such as meeting minutes, to show how decisions are made and improvements are implemented. Evidence like advisory meeting records, ASPIRE process updates, and community outreach efforts can demonstrate ongoing engagement and data-driven progress since our last accreditation in 2020.
