In January 2021, the ACCJC reaffirmed SBVC's accreditation for seven years, recognizing the strength of our Institutional Self-Evaluation Report (ISER) and the positive outcomes of our virtual campus visit in October 2020. This reaffirmation—the highest possible—reflects our dedication to excellence and continuous growth!

As part of this process, SBVC also received two recommendations to help us further enhance our effectiveness:

- **Recommendation 1**: Continue strengthening the SAO process for all student services to further improve programs and services. (I.B.2, II.C.2)
- **Recommendation 2**: Ensure that SLOs listed on syllabi align with the officially approved course outline of record. (II.A.3)
