1. Approval of 2/23/23 minutes	Tabled for next meeting.	
2. Spring 2023 Enrollment Update	The initial target was 9,002 FTES. We have been doing well. We are going to exceed our target and come in around 9,300 FTES. That is a positive sign as we work to return to being a medium-sized college with 10,000 FTES. We are on track to get back within the next two years. We need to grow about 4% next year, but we feel confident about it.

4. Student Services Monthly Programs	<p>On Tuesday Financial Aid held the resource fair. Financial aid did a wonderful job. The turnout was great. There was trivia, giveaways, games, and prizes. Thank you, Carmen, for your leadership. And thank you, everyone, for your support and for coming out and supporting.</p> <p>Black Excellence was held for feeder high schoolers to enjoy a day of motivation, presentations, workshops, food, and music. We had Concious Lee, a TikTok content creator, as a guest speaker; DJ Muda in the Greek Theater; a mental health panel. Almost 300 students from Colton, San Bernardino, Rialto and Redlands came out. We had students fill out a survey and almost everyone responded so we'll be recording that information.</p>	

There have been meetings regarding AB1705 which have new guidelines that indicate that all students need to enroll in transfer level math and English. We are revisiting what we were doing with the waivers as far as the students being able to not take the support class and just go straight into 101. That will not be the case going forward. We are taking a look at all of it. We are looking at the reports to the state chancellor's office and making sure we're meeting requirements. The goal is to have students complete transfer level math and English in one year and their pathways should reflect that.

In a month, Wednesday, May 24th. Currently 450 students have RSVP'd. Commencement will be at the 66ers Stadium. Commencement breakfast will be on site as well. We are going to do what we can to make it celebratory as well. We are working with KVCR to livestream it. Concession stands should be open. We are looking into t-shirt cannons as well. The deadline is May 12th. We always have students who miss the deadline. So, tell your students to RSVP and we'll send out a reminder in the coming weeks.

Can any student who is a summer graduate still stop by and get their name on the list? Yes. Have them stop by student life.

Students are checking in at 7:30 am. The ceremony starts at 9 am sharp.

Will there be any signage on campus letting them know that the ceremony will be held at the 66ers stadium?

We haven't talked about that but that's a good idea.

We are in the process of creating a student ambassador program. We are looking for 10 students who would like to support events on campus and work with specific departments. They can apply by May 1st. There's a monthly stipend. We are going to provide uniformity for the program to promote student leadership and retention.
