
## What Will Be The Future of Adult Education?

Educational leaders from throughout the Inland Empire are invited to a Town Hall Meeting to discuss an Adult Education Consortium program, based on state legislation (AB 86). This program will provide joint funding for adult education through the California Community College Chancellor's Office and the State Department of Education.

San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC) is hosting an AB 86 Town Hall Meeting on December 5, 2013, to invite community partners in adult education in our region to identify services currently being provided and those needed in the area of adult education.

This is a preliminary information-gathering meeting to gather information to help all parties to determine what role, if any, SBVC and San Bernardino Community College District (SBCCD) might play in a consortium effort. At this meeting, we hope to gain perspective on current services that will help us decide how to proceed when the state releases the Request for Application



(RFA) in late December or January providing funding for two years of planning and implementation.

This meeting is intended to solicit input and information from campus, education, and community partners. The meeting will not address the fiscal aspects of the project, including who will lead the consortium, if one is formed in our district. (Either the community college district or a K-12 district may be a lead in a consortium effort.) The goal is to encourage dialogue between adult education regional providers to familiarize each other with services and needs as a basis for how we might work together in the future.

Faculty, staff, and administrators from San Bernardino Valley College, SBCCD district, and Crafton Hills College are invited to attend this event along with regional education and community groups.
