

Facilities and Safety Committee

Charge

The Facilities and Safety Committee serves as an advisory committee to College Council regarding facilities, campus appearance, emergency preparedness, and safety. The committee reviews the capital outlay plan, identifies projects, and prioritizes needs identified in program review. The committee is apprised of emerging safety issues and makes recommendations for correction.

Membership

Membership comprises the Vice President of Administrative Services (co-chair), the Director of Facilities, Operations and Maintenance, and representatives from the following constituencies: CSEA (1), District Police (1) and Emergency Preparedness (1), Environmental Health and Safety (1), Classified (1), DSP&S (1), HR (1), Students (2), Management (2), and Faculty (5). The committee is co-chaired by one non-management member elected by the committee each year. The committee may choose to divide into separate sub-committees for safety and facilities as desired, or required by the committee workload during the year, each reporting back to the Facilities and Safety Committee.

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
