7210

ACADEMIC EMPLOYEES, NON-MANAGEMENT

Academic employees are all persons employed by the District in academic positions. Academic
positions include every type of service, other than paraprofessional service, for which the Board
of Governors has established minimum qualifications for the California Community Colleges.

Faculty members are those employees who are employed by the District in academic positions that are not designated as supervisory or management. Faculty employees include, but are not limited to, instructors, librarians, counselors, and professionals in health services, DSPS, and EOPS.

15 Decisions regarding tenure of faculty shall be made in accordance with the evaluation 16 procedures established for the evaluation of probationary faculty and in accordance with the 17 requirements of the Education Code. The Board reserves the right to determine whether a 18 faculty member shall be granted tenure.

19 20 The District may employ temporary faculty from time to time as required by the interests of the 21 District. Temporary faculty may be employed full time or part time. The Board delegates 22 authority to the Chancellor to determine the extent of the District's needs for temporary faculty.

Notwithstanding this policy, the District shall comply with its goals under the Education Code regarding the ratio of full-time to part-time faculty to be employed by it and the Title 5-required District five-year plan for making progress toward the standard of 75% of total faculty work load hours taught by full-time faculty.

All collective bargaining agreements between the Board and the San Bernardino Community College District Teachers Association shall be considered as policies of the Board.
