He also reviewed a resolution regarding permitting of a 2 year limit (modify Title 5) to interim management appointments by a District. Two resolutions (9.04 and 9.05 respectively) involving College Level Examination Program (CLEP) exams and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. CLEP exams are becoming an issue for campuses due to their use in providing assessment for overseas military personnel. J Stanskas recommended that CLEP exam issue be studied by Ed Policy in association with the articulation officer to study and streamline the process. J Stanskas also reviewed Resolution 13.03 concerning reviewing and renewing policies on Academic Freedom and studied for possible inclusion into our contract. Lastly the three papers previously distributed (Prerequisites and Content Review, Library Stds and Practice, and SLO Assessment) were all approved.
