TOPIC	DISCUSSION and ACTION
Approval of October 19, 2011 Minutes	The minutes were approved with the following changes:  Campus Technology:  APA (spelling) to Apple IPADS to iPads
Committee Structure – D. Daniels	Two changes to the committee structure were addressed: (1) the addition of the Strategic Planning Task Force; (2) to make Basic Skills into a global committee that will link to the planning and student success model.  After a brief discussion John requested Basic Skills be added as a new committee to the committee structure (as recommended by the Academic Senate). Consensus was to add Basic Skills as a committee and to charge the Basic Skills committee (once it has been established) with writing the committee charge.  Discussion ensued about where Strategic Planning would fall under the committee structure, or whether it would require its own committee. It was concluded to move forward with planning and the committees as they stand to observe the most natural fit for Strategic Planning.

Student Success Taskforce Recommendation – J. Stanskas	John reported that he sent out the link to the recorded discussion at the Fall 2011 Plenary Session regarding the Student Success Task Force Recommendations with members of the task force to the campus (http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-LfDzAH82pw).  Academic Senate will look at input regarding the Student Success Taskforce Recommendations in their meeting today. Another draft will be complete and sent to the Board of Governors in December for adoption in January.
Student Success Measures (Prerequisite) – J. Stanskas	John handed out a summary of activities on the prerequisite discussion that took place on October 19 <sup>th</sup> which the Academic Senate has adopted (see attachment). The summaries included instructional, student support, administrative and organizational considerations. Highlighted in the summaries are anticipated activities, items and funds needed to accomplish activities.  After discussion, Deb recommended that the summary of activities be forwarded to the Basic Skills committee in an effort to operationalize. In addition, a review of the prerequisite challenge process has been forwarded to the matriculation committee. She asked that the Basic Skills committee take necessary action and give recommendations to determine funds needed. The group gave consensus to forward and charge the Basic Skills committee with presenting an action plan by the end of this semester.
Committee Assignments – D. Daniels	Deb handed out the committee assignment list and asked the group to review the meeting times listed, make suggestions and send to her by Monday so that the list can be updated and sent to John for fall 2012 (for the next 2 year term).

- Fund creation of visual pathways in a variety of media regarding enrollment processes

- Dialog between content experts and basic skills experts in review of Course Outline of Record (part Senate work today)
- Develop/adopt rubrics for prerequisite considerations (Curriculum Committee/Senate)
