VideoMobile	Michael Torrez demonstrated one of his videos that are now hosted at YouTube. This led to a lengthy discussion of mobile devices. Glen Kuck said that the two new positions being hired by the district would be tasked with investigating the Blackboard Learn App and other issues regarding students accessing their online classes through mobile devices. Mobile is already here. The Online Program Committee needs to be aware of the issues, coordinate with Professional Development, and help faculty migrate existing resources into formats that are mobile friendly.
Substantive Changeagain	Jackson reported that 3 certificates and 10 degrees meet the 50% DE threshold, with more Transfer Degrees on the horizon that would also meet the threshold. Jackson will communicate these findings to the VPI. The committee will continue to monitor compliance with ACCJC policies and make recommendations to the VPI at an appropriate time.
