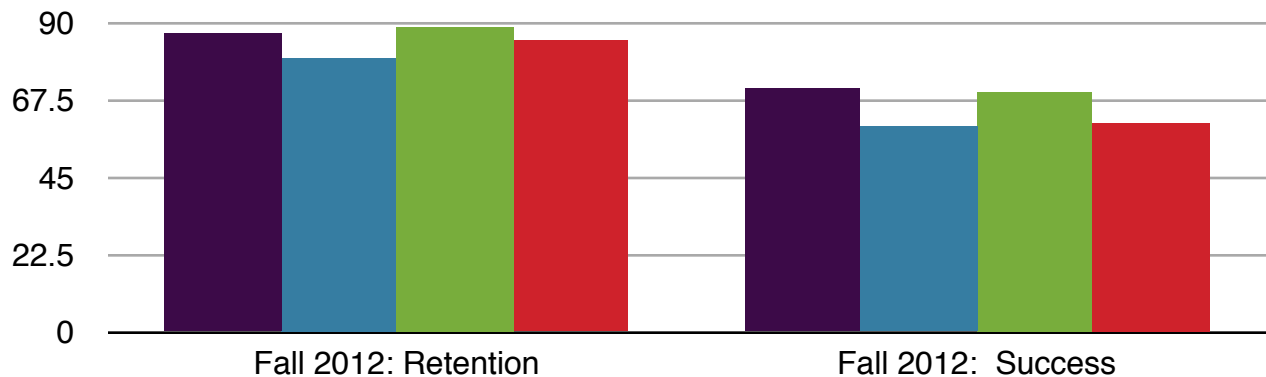

Analysis: SBVC retention rates exceed that of the state. SBVC success rates mirror that of the state. All DE statistics are below the non-DE statistics for the state and the college. Delta between state non-DE and DE is smaller for SBVC than for the state. Good! Focus on success to make sure SBVC hits its institution-set standard for DE.
